Summary of PPG spending 2014/15

Objectives in spending PPG:

- To narrow the gap to national expectation for those pupils in receipt of pupil premium
- To ensure that all pupils in receipt of pupil premium make 2 whole levels progress between Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2
- To ensure that progress is accelerated for those pupils in receipt of pupil premium
- To enrich the curriculum and provide experiences to enhance progress in academic, social and emotional development

Summary of spending and actions taken for 2014-15 academic year:

- TA intervention £6000
- 1-1 support and interventions £ 2500
- Staff Training £850
- Support with cost of trips and after school activities £630

Outcomes to date:

- PP intervention ensured progress literacy of at least expected standard for all children. 50% made more than expected and closed gap.
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- 1-1 intervention used to support personal and social needs.
- Continued grammar and punctuation training for staff will impact on PP children's writing attainment over next academic year.
- All PP supported to attend after school activities over the academic year and trips were funded to enrich their curriculum experience.

Planned spending and actions for 2015-16 academic year:

- Support for residential payments and subsidised curriculum enrichment.
- Release TA to support Lower Key Stage 2 .
- To continue to narrow the gap to national expectation for those pupils in receipt of pupil premium through TA intervention.
