Summary of PPG spending 2015/2016

Objectives in spending PPG:

- Support for residential payments and subsidised curriculum enrichment.
- Release class assistants to work 1-1 in KS2 with children on boosting writing and maths skills.
- To continue to narrow the gap to national expectation for those pupils in receipt of pupil premium through TA intervention.

Summary of spending and actions taken for 2015-2016 academic year:

- TA interventions – £10,000
- 1:1 support and interventions - £3000
- Support with cost of trips and after school activities – £850
- Staff Training - £850

Outcomes to date:

- All pupils attended trips and residential. School uniform and afterschool clubs were subsidised.
- 9/12 children working at Age Related expectations. Those who are not have made good progress. All PP children made progress through year and interventions supported learning successfully.

Planned spending and actions for 2016-2017 academic year:

- Subsidise cost of extra-curricular activities including school visits, residential visits and after-school clubs in order to ensure equality of access for all pupils.
- Provide enrichment programme which targets maths and literacy skills on an individual basis and ensures that children eligible for Pupil Premium achieve as well as their peers or better.
